The Certified Pool Operator Exam will be given on Thursday, April 14, 2016, at 2121 W. Taylor Street in Chicago. The exam will be given by Phil Klein of the West Chicago Regional Office.

Please bring with you two pencils, and a non-programmable calculator--cellular phones are not permitted for use. **Photo identification is required to take the exam and to enter the testing facility.**

The 100 multiple choice question exam requires study of both the *Study Guide* and *Pool Code* as provided in the links below. This is not an open book exam. A score of 75% or more is needed to pass, and to be awarded a Certificate as a Certified Swimming Pool Operator. This exam is given free of charge and may be taken as many times as given.

Prior to the exam, a brief review session will be held. Please arrive at the facility **NO LATER** than 9:45 AM.


