SUMMARY ANNUAL REPORT FOR International Union of Operating Engineers Local 399 Health Reimbursement Account Plan

This is a summary of the annual report for International Union of Operating Engineers Local 399 Health Reimbursement Account Plan, EIN 47-1259234, for the year ended May 31, 2019. The annual report has been filed with the Employee Benefit Security Administration, as required under the Employee Retirement Income Security Act of 1974 (ERISA).

Basic Financial Statement

The value of plan assets, after subtracting liabilities of the plan was \$6,819,255 as of May 31, 2019 compared to \$3,848,014 as of June 1, 2018. During the plan year, the plan experienced an increase in its net assets of \$2,971,241. During the plan year, the plan had total income of \$3,075,038 including (but not limited to) employer contributions of \$3,038,135 and earnings from investments of \$36,903.

Plan expenses were \$103,797. These expenses included \$56,702 in administrative expenses and \$47,095 in benefits paid to participants and beneficiaries.

If you request a copy of the full annual report from the plan administrator, these two statements and accompanying notes will be included as part of that report. The charge to cover the copying costs given above does not include a charge for the copying of these portions of the report because these portions are furnished without charge.

You also have the legally protected right to examine the annual report at the main office of the plan at 2260 South Grove Street, Chicago, IL 60616 and the U.S. Department of Labor in Washington, D.C., or to obtain a copy from the U.S. Department of Labor upon payment of copying costs.
